As a department we are observing a significant decrease in expected performance by many students--too many--early in this first quarter. We are greatly concerned by the profound apathy exhibited in too many of our students as compared to their performance last fall and are actively brainstorming ideas to motivate and instill optimism in our students to turn their much poorer performance around. Being hybrid now, some of our co-curricular activities are getting off the ground such as our "Raider Team", Color Guard, E-Sports, etc. which is helping to attract some cadet involvement, yet the decrease in enthusiasm and participation rates due to COVID fears and apparent outright psychological depression is profound.
