- If you are accepted, you will receive information over the summer





AVID is part of the school-wide commitment to college readiness @ JICHS.

AVID is both an elective class and a series of skills taught throughout the campus. All students in the school use AVID writing, inquiry, collaboration, organization, & reading skills, which help students become scholars.

In the elective class, a group of students meet during the school day to receive targeted support in a small-group setting. AVID prepares average students for four-year college eligibility. The students are capable of completing a college prep curriculum with support, accountability, and encouragement.
