## HOSA Blood Drive- message from Coach Walker

The members of HOSA did a FANTASTIC job along with the American Red Cross that was indeed understaffed. We were able to secure 58 pints of blood which surpassed our set goal of 55 !!!!

I was able to speak to a donor yesterday who is also an ICU nurse and was caring for a patient two days prior but COULD NOT obtain platelets as ordered to properly serve her patient - our work yesterday will impact multiple patients and SAVE LIVES!

## **Professional Development- Restorative Practices**

The last of three professional development days planned for our staff is this Friday. It is day two of restorative practices training. The focus of our PD is building relational capacity with our students. We are providing lunch from Martin's BBQ starting at 11:30 am. The board is welcome to join us.

### January 3, 2021

This day is currently a teacher workday. As a holiday gift, I shortened the day to 4-hours. Staff who completed the EIR survey and debriefing meeting earned four hours of comp which they can use on this day to extend their holiday break.

## EIR Grant Update

The majority of our staff have completed their individual IDI survey debriefings. Staff that complete all requirements are now able to use \$1,500 for PD on cultural competency.

### **CERT Testing**

Round two of three of CERT testing was last week. Round three is the week of April 18. The CERT test is given in CREW for students in grades 9-11. By giving it in CREW, we can assure nearly 100% of students in those grades take the test, which will provide longitudinal data for our school. CERT is designed to help students improve their scores on the ACT and SAT tests. As a reminder, CERT also provides a vocabulary builder and graduation planner for students.

Marty is working with various vendors to get quotes to convert and renovate student restrooms for a second staff restroom facility. We currently do not have any staff restrooms on the second floor. This project qualifies under ESSER funds.
