## **ILT Expectations 12.9.21**

We need the academic areas of the building to be reasonably quiet so students and teachers can work. The hallways, especially the Science lobby, have poor acoustics so sound travels or is significantly magnified.

The hall is not the mall. The hallways are only for going to classrooms or designated student spaces (from A to B).

# **Expectations for the Hallways**

- no sitting on floors
- no doing laps
- students may only move in groups of 4 or less.
- The primary restrooms for ILT are located by the cafeteria and ROTC hallway.
- ILT Common Spaces must not exceed capacity. They must be quiet, kept clean, or closed. Add signage
- Music should not be played out loud (no speakers). Please use your earbuds.

# **Expectations for the Bathrooms**

- No food in restrooms
- No loiter in restrooms
- No sitting on floors in restrooms
- No group bathroom visits
- One person per stall. Multiple occupants in a stall is automatic OSS. Additional infractions may be added (vaping, drug possession/usage, sexual act).

## **Expectations for ILT**

- ILT is not recess. High school students do not have recess.
- No running, horseplay, etc.
- Music should not be played out loud (no speakers). Please use your earbuds.
- Late to third period- loss of ILT for student

# Common Areas Open for Use During ILT

- Cafeteria
- Courtyards
- Breezeway
- Troy's Diner
- Band Practice field- sports activities
- Students may walk laps around the Band Practice field
- Music should not be played out loud (no speakers).

## **Senior Privilege**

Qualified seniors may leave for lunch with parent permission form provided seniors meet all of the required qualifications for the privilege.

Senior CREW is 35 minutes

## **Qualifications for Senior Privileges**

- Be classified as a senior and on pace to graduate.
- Must attend CREW- lunch paperwork will be done through CREW teacher.

- Must not be over allotted absences (5 for semester, 3 for quarter).
- No disciplinary issues (referrals, etc.).
- Must be passing all classes on interims and report cards. (60% or 70%)

# **Expectations for Off-Campus Senior Lunch**

- Must drive safely at all times (no reckless driving off campus).
- Seniors must attend CREW or they do not qualify for the privilege (disciplinary issue)
- Must leave and return through the back or front atriums.
- Do not bring food back into the school.
- Vehicles may be searched before leaving and upon returning (trucks of cars, etc.).
- Students will not engage in any illegal, illicit or inappropriate activities while off-campus. You represent our school out in the community.

# Consequences for Violations of the Expectations

- Late to third period- three strikes & you're out. (how to enforce)
- Smuggling underclassmen out during ILT- automatic loss of privilege for the remainder of year and
  disciplinary referral for all those involved. Underclassmen that get caught leaving jeopardize this
  privilege as a senior. How to track.
- Returning to school impaired- loss of privileges for the remainder of the year, disciplinary referral, and police contact (driving while impaired, under the influence, etc.).

Tardy Sweep Reboot- Teachers will close their door when tardy bell rings. Students are expected to be in their seat, ready to learn when the bell rings.
