International Baccalaureate

23 IB Students and five staff members traveled to Prague for IB CAS Trip (April 7-15). CAS (Creativity, activity, and service) is one of the three essential elements every student must complete as part of the Diploma Programme (DP). This is the second time our IB students have traveled to Prague. Other CAS trips have been to Costa Rica.

School Pass

The admin team recently met the company SchoolPass to learn about their comparable product to SmartPass. This system piqued our interest because it integrates with PowerSchool (PS). With this system, students scan into class using a barcode or QR code when they arrive, and their attendance is automatically recorded in PS. The system takes attendance for the teacher. When students leave for a hall pass, they scan out of the class by selecting from various options (restroom, drinking fountain, clinic, etc.). The hall passes are time, and like SmartPass, a dashboard shows all active hall passes. When they return to class, they scan back in, recording when they are out of class. We can also have students scan in when they arrive or leave school. The system integrates with Raptor, so it also works for visitors. This system includes a digital ID. There is also a feature for staff to sign in and out, which has a geofence feature. This allows us to know exactly who is on campus at all times.

The program costs slightly less than what we pay for the SmartPass system. The key step is if CCSD will SchoolPass to integrate with PS.

Bell/Class Schedules Study: Our Leadership Team will study various bell schedule options next year. The 4x4 block schedule has its pros and cons. For example, teaching math for 90 minutes five days a week is difficult. For some students, being in classes for 90 minutes is difficult. Another concern is the time of day students have certain classes. First period classes, students are generally quiet and harder to engage. By the fourth period, some students are worn out. Other options we will study are the modified block and flex module schedule. With these bell schedules, the class period ranges from 90 to 45 minutes. The students would have a class three or four times a week.

The 4x4 has worked well and is the norm in South Carolina.

Cell Phone System and Policy

After a year of doing regular walkthroughs, it is apparent that cell phone use in class is a significant issue for some teachers. The consensus from the Leadership Team and our teachers is that teachers would like a school-wide cell policy. The administration does provide Yondr bags for any teacher that would like them. The Leadership is exploring options. We may expand the use of Yondr bags in all classrooms.
