Semester Exams

Semester 1 exams started on Wednesday, January 17th, and conclude tomorrow. Wednesday is a teacher workday, and the second semester begins on Thursday, January 25th. We will be analyzing our benchmark testing and EOC data starting next week. Next semester, all EOC teachers will receive professional development on benchmark testing to help them maximize the potential of benchmarking testing.

SchoolPass/SmartPass

We successfully transitioned from SchoolPass to SmartPass, and the system works well. The SCS now have iPads on straps to help patrol the halls throughout the day. We are working on the kiosk mode in the classrooms and various other locations to maximize the system's potential.

YONDR

YONR continues to work well for our school. The feedback from the teachers and through the Leadership Team is highly positive. Several teachers say it is the best thing we've ever done. We have gone through many YONDR pouches because students usually break the pin or cut a hole. Based on the recommendations from YONDR, we will increase the price of replacements as follows: 1st \$10, 2nd \$15, 3rd \$20. For the first semester, the price of a replacement pouch was only \$5 and did not increase.

Unified Program

On February 23rd, we are having a pep rally to recognize the Unified Program for achieving the distinction of National Unified Champion Schools on behalf of Special Olympics. Representatives from the Special Olympics will present the schools with the banner.

Bell Schedule Committee (BSC)

The BSC committee visited WAHS before the holiday break and met several times recently to discuss various bell schedule options. The flex mod schedule is intriguing, but WAHS is experiencing some learning curves. Staff feedback is mixed, but more negative than positive. Ultimately, the committee recommended bringing back skinny periods during periods 2 and 3. Skinnies or 45-minute yearlong classes are better suited for certain classes (World Language, SPED, etc). The Leadership Team is considering the recommendation. If the Leadership Team and teachers want to change the bell schedule for next year, we will seek board approval this spring.
