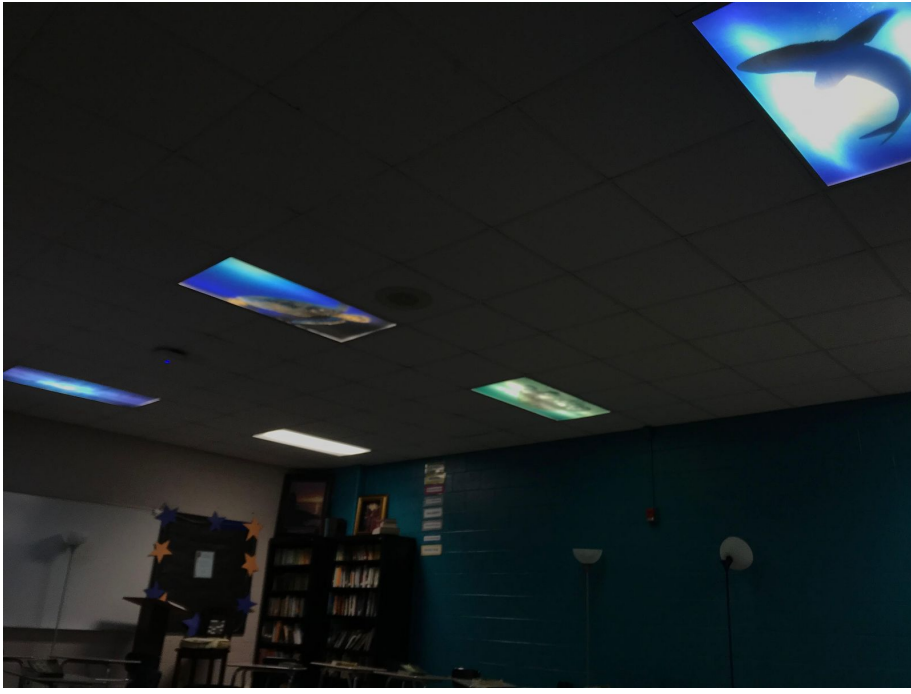
## **FINE ARTS:**
