# **ESOL- WIDA Testing in February**

Mrs. Morillo and I once again are meeting with all of our ESOL students that will be taking the WIDA test. The results of these tests go on our school report card. We will be offering the same incentive as last year, which is \$10 card for each section they pass or \$50 if they exit the program. Last year we had 24 students exit the program, and we doubled the points in the category on the state report card (3.5 to 7 out of 10 pts). We will also buy them lunch when we meet with them, which they really enjoyed last year. Mrs. Morillo and I will continue to emphasize to the students the importance of them receiving their necessary accommodations from their teachers. We want to them to be successful on the test and in the classroom. These accommodations are a legal requirement just like a 504 or special education services.

We have been using this program for years. It has recently been updated and the changes are all common sense and understandable. I am proud that we have helped lead the district in this direction over the years. Mr. Edwards is planning student safety trainings for February.

## **Vape Detectors**

Mr. Edwards has been pricing out vape detectors for our restrooms. He and Mrs. Holland visited Bishop England (BE) to see them in action. They were extremely impressed. The admin BE raved about the devices. We are exploring these for our school.

# **CTE Wing and Competition Gym**

We recently met with CCSD, Cumming, and the Architects to review the timeline, location of trailers, and summer logistics. The trailer in-use will be relocated on the Band practice field. Construction is expected to last a year and a half. The new CTE wing and Gym are expected to be completed by the winter of 2021.

#### James Island Bus Lot

The City of Charleston BZA Zoning Board voted down the JI Bus Lot Project. They did approve the CTE wing and Gym project. At this point, CCSD could take legal action. I am not sure if they will or not.
